Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to you on behalf of Governors to explain how the school's ongoing funding is managed and how your contribution allows us to sustain the level of classroom resources our children benefit from.

We are extremely proud of our school and the learning environment it provides. I am sure you will agree that there is something special about Horsell Village School and the holistic education our children receive. Our Teaching Assistants are an essential part of this offer to the children. As individuals and collectively as a team they provide an important contribution. Having Teaching Assistants in each class allows our teachers to focus on much smaller groups of 15 at a time generating the learning environment where the children can thrive.

Unfortunately, Teaching Assistants are not mandated by Government; and funding for any additional staff must be generated internally. Staff expenditure accounts for over 75% of our total spending so, after much debate, the governing body made the difficult decision to ask our school families to consider supporting the school financially. Additionally, recent increases in staffing costs- including those due to the longer school day- have not been covered by an equivalent increase in government funding.

The generous support that we have been given by parents over the last several years has allowed us to maintain the level of support provided by Teaching Assistants and provide care and attention we believe the children deserve so we hope to continue this proven path with your help.

Any donation is greatly appreciated. As a guide, we are suggesting a regular standing order of £25 per month per family, but you can select the amount you feel able to offer. You can amend or cancel your monthly payment at any time should your circumstances change and there is absolutely no obligation for those who are uncomfortable with donating.

We are a registered Charity, and for those of you who are taxpayers and contribute via payroll/matched giving (Give As You Earn) or can Gift Aid the donation, we would welcome the additional monies as this can add another 25% to your donation with no impact on yourself. Some guidance on how you can support us is enclosed.

As a Governing Body, we are always investigating additional sources of income from other sources, such as local businesses, and various employer-related schemes. What makes this request so important is that regular income allows us to plan ahead to ensure that money is available. One-off gifts and initiatives are always gratefully received but by their nature are variable so make planning and budgeting more challenging.
