Drop off and pick up

To make drop off and pick up run smoothly, please can we request that you:

- Arrive between the allocated times. The school gates open at 8.35am in the mornings and will close at 8.50am. Learning starts as soon as they children are in.
- Please do not use your mobile phone on site, during drop off and pick up. We have a duty of care to safeguard all children.
- If coming in at the front of the school, through the small side gate, please only use this to enter. It becomes very congested at this small gate.
- If you are running late (we know things happen) please ring the school office to keep us informed - this helps us to prepare your child/children - especially at the end of a school day.
- If someone different is picking up, please inform the school office before 2.30pm. Messages received at 3.20pm do not allow the office staff sufficient time to get to the classrooms.
- Please be considerate of our neighbours when parking.

Finally, could we ask that once you have dropped off or picked up your child that you do not congregate on the drive into the car park. It gets very busy during these times and this area can become especially congested for other members of the public.


