Our Teaching

Intent

At The Horsell Village School, we aim is to provide a music curriculum which engages and inspires children to develop a love of music. Through music children will develop in self confidence and enjoy singing, composing and performing. They will be exposed to a wide range of music styles and have the opportunities to listen to live music

<u>Implementation</u>

Our curriculum is centred round 'Inside Music'. A programme which centres around the voice and has singing as the dominant performing medium. In combination with performance which includes body action and movement, children have the opportunity to develop an understanding of phrase, pulse, rhythm, pitch and early notation.

Voices teaching is integrated within the school day and weekly Singings Reflections allow children to revisit key songs previously learnt and learn new songs connected to wider curriculum areas, festivals and celebrations as a whole school community.

Enrichment

Our music curriculum is enriched through the opportunity to work both independently and as part of a group, ensuring that skills of resilience and teamwork are promoted. A variety of musical activities are provided and children have the opportunity to perform outside of school within our local community to ensure that they understand the significance of music and its place within the wider world. Visiting musicians and the local Woking High Orchestra provide children with opportunities to hear live music.
