Clubs will begin on Monday 14th January and will run for 5 weeks, ending on Monday 11th February.

We run a range of after school activities for children in Year 1 and 2; this is a great way for your child to learn new skills or practise something they enjoy doing. These clubs are free of charge. **The children will go straight to their club after school. After their club has finished, they will be taken back to their own class to be dismissed.** If your child attends After School Club, then they will all be taken by a member of staff to the After School Club. Some activities have a maximum number so we'll allocate places by drawing names out of a hat.

Lego

The children will use Lego to create a range of structures.

Playdough

The children will enjoy getting creative with playdough whilst developing their fine motor skills through the actions of squashing, rolling and flattening.

Hockey

The children will develop their hand-eye co-ordination as they develop their skills in dribbling, passing and shooting.

Basketball

The children will be practising ball skills and developing their ability to work in a team.

Street Dance

The children will be learning dance moves and linking these together to create dances.

Computing

The children will use iPads to access useful apps that will help your child to practise basic computing skills. Some of these are highly creative and require problem solving stamina from the children.

Winter Wonderland

The children will use 'Winter', as stimuli to create snow poems, seasonal art work and carry out science investigations based around ice.

Craft

The children will use a range of different materials and skills to create various art works and models.

Shape investigations

The children will plan and carry out a range of investigations involving both 2D and 3D shape.

Singing

Children will work collaboratively as an ensemble to develop their performance skills and confidence, furthering their ambitions to be creative and perform in front of one another.
