



Science

As scientists we will be looking at where our food comes from, what plants need to grow and using our senses to explore different tastes, textures and smells of food. We will be exploring different foods from around the world and seeing how far our food travels to get to our plate.



Life Skills—PSHE

As members of our school community we will be looking at ways we can incorporate our new motto 'kindness to ourselves, kindness to others, kindness to the world' into our day to day lives. We will be learning how to stay healthy through a balanced diet and looking after our bodies and we will be thinking about what it is to 'me in my world'.

English

In phonics we will be revisiting all the sounds we have learned so far and exploring adjacent consonant. Eg. t-e-nt, st-o-p.

In English we will be looking at a range of different texts to explore how sentences are constructed and writing our own, including capital letters and full stops. We will be learning about verbs and adjectives. We will be sequencing stories and describing characters as well as making changes to familiar stories.

Art

Maths

As mathematicians we will be exploring numbers to 20 and using two-digit numbers to add and subtract. We will be writing number sentences and exploring number facts within 20. We will also be identifying and representing numbers using objects and pictorial representations.
