In reading, we will be practising applying our phonic knowledge to new words and learning how to read ahead to see what makes sense if a word can't be sounded out. We will also be answering questions about our reading and looking at the key features of fiction and non-fiction texts.

In writing, we will be using a range of pictures, illustrations and stories to inspire our own writing including: Mrs Armitage on Wheels and The Hundred Decker Bus.

As designers, we will be working together to plan and make a class sculpture of our own.


We will be learning about wheels and axles and creating wheeled vehicles of our own.
